Congratulations to Year One /Two students (Blayk & Jake) for sharing information about their pets using the Japanese language. They both presented five different facts about the pets. Well done!




STUDENTS OF THE WEEK

We then usually have supper and clean up the hall.


SUSTAINABILITY GARDEN
