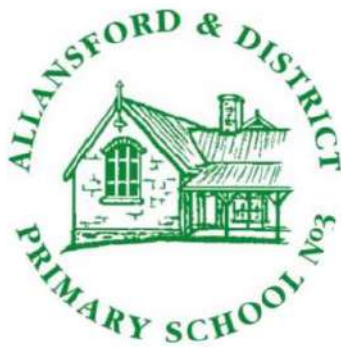
## DRESS UP PARADE
