### Time in Lieu Explanation

Under the new teaching agreement, staff are required to be paid for additional time outside their normal hours of work if they perform required duties deemed by the school.

In the case of camps, direct payment for all 'Time in Lieu' would make the cost of camps too high.

In order to have camps, and keep costs at an acceptable level, staff have agreed, and School Council have approved **Friday 20<sup>th</sup> October** as a 'Time in Lieu' day for all staff due to their involvement in camp week activities.

Without the approval of a "Time in Lieu" day, our camps would not be viable.

Feedback from parent surveys strongly endorsed having a camping experience and endorsed costings being in an affordable range.

We have been able to provide this experience and now require your support with camp payments and supporting "Time in Lieu" arrangements.

This means no staff and no school program will operate on **Friday 20<sup>th</sup> October**.

Parents who are unable to supervise their children on that day can contact the school and the school will have to employ a teacher to run an alternative program.

## STUDENTS OF THE WEEK

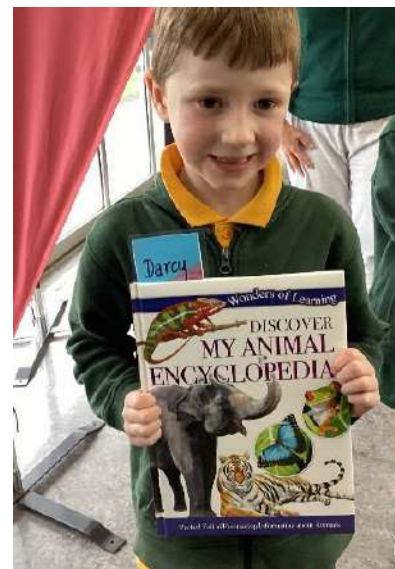
The students pictured below were selected for last week's "Student of the Week." They all in some way shone brightly in front of their teachers and peers. Congratulations to you all!
