WELCOME BACK FOR TERM THREE

We welcome all students, staff and extended families back to school for an exciting 10 weeks of learning in Term 3.

Firstly, I would like to thank our parents for making an effort to engage with staff as part of the mid-year interview process. In a great result, we had over 90% of our parents book an interview to discuss their child's achievements and areas for further improvement.

Secondly, I want to thank all staff for the process undertaken in writing student reports and for the time and effort staff put into analysing student data and moderating student work so as to accurately reflect individual student growth and achievement. Well done!

Thirdly, I want to acknowledge some very positive student learning results for semester one. Our ultimate goal is for all students to make 6 months learning growth or greater in the first two terms of the year.

The following indicates the percentage of students across the school who made 6 months or greater growth in the identified subject areas:

Reading – **89%** of students

Writing – **87%** of students

S&L – **91%** of students

Math Number – **89%** of students

We also had some excellent results for those students who participated in the Tutor Learning Initiative in terms 1+ 2 of this year. **95%** of students in this program achieved 6 months or greater growth and of these **20%** achieved 12 months growth.

Fourthly, we welcome Mrs Sheldon back for semester two and know that many students are looking forward to learning the Japanese language and learning about significant cultural events. We welcome Felicity to the Year 3/4 whilst Mrs Henry is on leave. We also welcome Jacki who will be replacing Jeannette whilst on leave for Term 3 in supporting identified students. We welcome Sheree, who will be implementing Sounds Write intervention for identified groups across the school.
