I want to acknowledge the staff for their professionalism in planning for home learning when given so little notice and the support they continue to offer to students. Teachers will guide you and your child's learning at home. We aim to keep things as simple and meaningful as possible. We understand that some days things just won't go as planned and that's OK, please take care and do your best.

Teachers will send out daily work requirements via Dojo that assist with understanding the Learning Pack. Morning wellbeing check ins will happen daily via WebEx /Dojo and teachers will communicate times.

WebEx meetings are a chance for teachers to maintain contact and connections with the whole class and for students to remain connected to their classmates – teachers will communicate updates, messages, mark the roll and talk about day/week ahead. Teachers will also communicate times for your child to participate in WebEx small group workshops.
