#### PRINCIPAL CHATTER

It was great to see students return to on-site learning this week. There is nothing better than seeing smiles on student's faces and kids learning and playing together. I was very proud of the manner in which our school community approached the recent lockdown and in the manner the school supported students and families whilst learning from home. As a school community, we have to prepared to act on health advice and government guidelines and move in and out of remote learning with very little advanced warning.





The department's 2021 Parent Opinion Survey is currently open, and some 40 families have been randomly selected to receive a survey link and log in details. #### **SCHOOL COUNCIL**

It was great to see some robust discussion about some key agenda items and implications moving forward in the Covid landscape. School Council approved the following items at this week's meetina:

- 1 The School Dental Initiative visitation preference for Term 1 + Term 2 in 2022
- 2 The Complaints Policy + Headlice Policy Fraud & Corruption Policy (School Council agreed to make some further additions to the Excursion Policy prior to approval)
- 3 An application for Out of School Home Care (OSHC) to be established at ADPS.
- 4 The Foundation BBQ / Activities + Year One & Two BBQ / Activities with Year One & Two having a sleepover at school in Term 4 at a date to be determined subject to health restrictions.
- 5 The Artist in Residence Program to go ahead in week 8 of this term subject to health advice with the understanding that there is very little chance of having the traditional whole school performance.
- 6 Participation in the Cows Create Careers Program this term subject to current health advice.
- 7 The go ahead to run the Bunnings BBQ this Saturday, with little notice of changes to restrictions.
- 8 We started a conversation on what learning would be like for a student at Allansford & District Primary School moving towards 2030 in preparation for our 2022 School Review. We looked at trends that are happening across the world and the key knowledge, attitudes, values and skills required for students to reach their full potential and for the well-being of our community.
