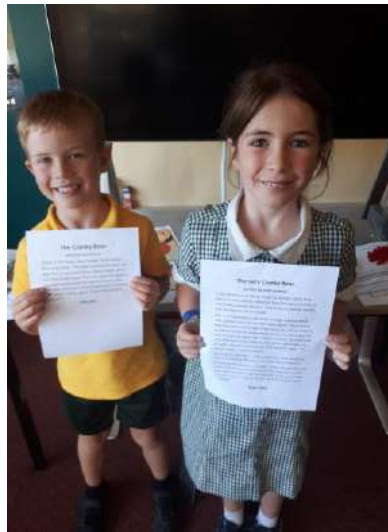
SHOW CASE
