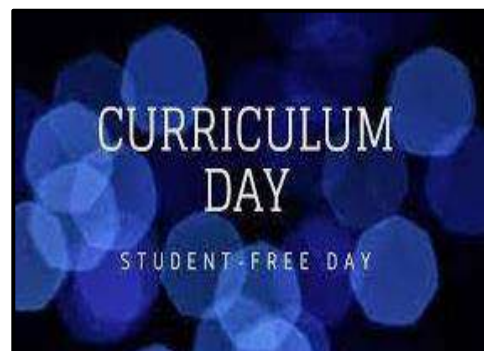
JUNIOR SCHOOL CROSS-COUNTRY
