Staff Training Day Report

Our staff had a very enlightening day last Friday as they participated in Community Understanding and safety Training conducted by our local Koorie Education Support Officers.

The day began with the introduction of how the training relates to the Marrung: Aboriginal Education Plan 2016 – 2026. We looked at history, pre and post colonisation and the many policies that impacted aboriginal people. We learnt about the local Koorie community in this area and the breakdown of groups and organisations.

The second session focused largely on data and sharing some great resources for learning about indigenous culture and traditions.
