STUDENT AWARDS

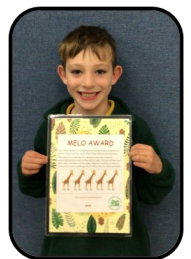
Congratulations on the fantastic efforts you have all shown for a huge range of skills and achievements. You should be proud of your achievements – We certainly are!

The "Wellbeing Award" went to *Tainui* who has been having a go at everything. *Congratulations* Tainui.

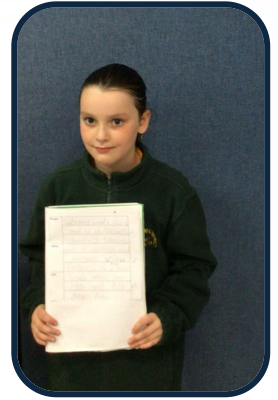

FRIENDLY REMINDERS

★ COUNTRY BUS REMINDER ★

The Country Bus Co-ordinator Tania Malone has asked schools to forward the message below to all schools.

We have recently been advised by bus operators that a significant number of students who are not approved or registered travellers have been accessing Country Bus services.

To ensure compliance with School Bus Program requirements, please note that the following conditions apply to all travellers:

- Only students who are approved and registered for their designated Country Bus service are permitted to travel.
- Students must travel to and from their approved bus stop only.
- Country Bus services are provided exclusively for travel to and from school and must not be used for sports training, employment, social activities, or any other non-school-related purposes.
- Parents/carers are responsible for arranging alternative transport where travel falls outside the approved use of the service.

Please ensure that staff and families are informed of these travel conditions, with regular reminders provided through school communication channels, including the school newsletter.

We appreciate your assistance in reinforcing these requirements with students and families and thank you for your ongoing cooperation in supporting the safe and appropriate operation of the School Country Bus Program.
