This week the Kindness Award was presented to **Morgan**.

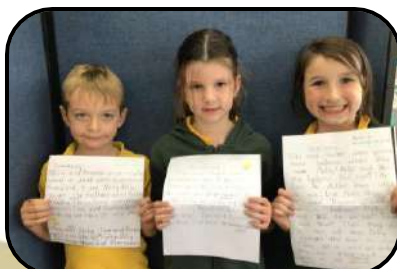
