The **Melo Award** was presented to **Darcy D.** who stopped his work to quickly help solve a problem in ICT. *Congratulations* Darcy.

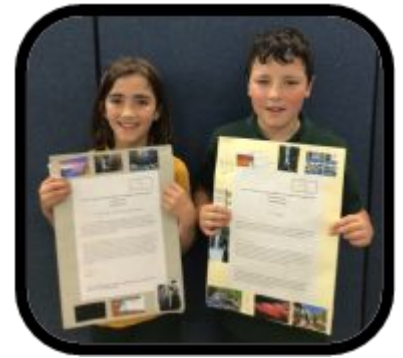


The '**Wellbeing Award**' went to **Evie** who helped other students who were having a hard time working out their Maths problems. *Congratulations* Evie.

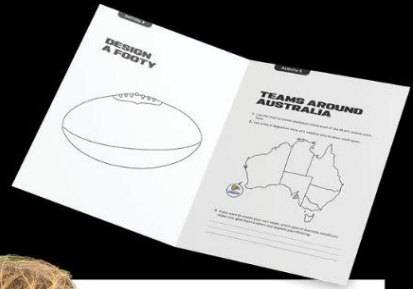
