The more bookings that come from the Allansford school , the more funds raised, with all monies going toward updating the school's digital devices.

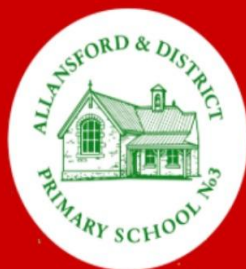
