Congratulations to Darci, Lucy, Bonnie, Matilda and Harry for celebrating a birthday last week.



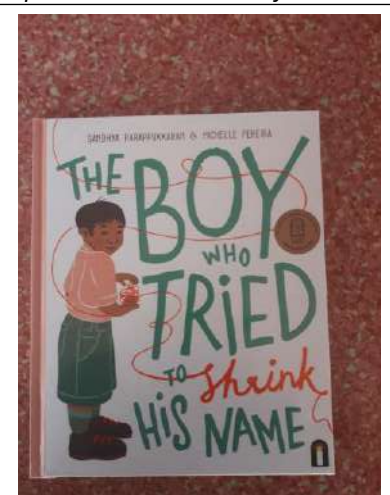
### Science Week

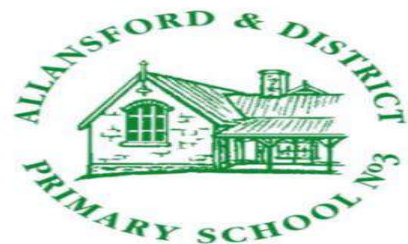
