Principal Conference

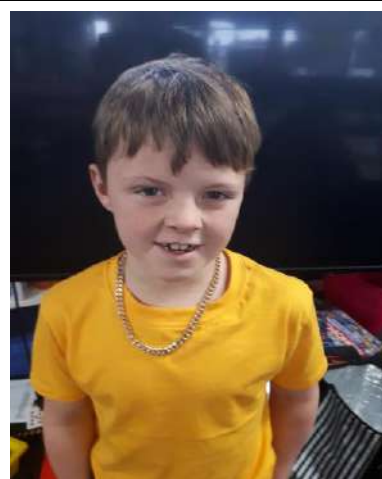
