ADPS was successful in achieving a \$25,000 grant to purchase and instal a shade covering some asphalt area to provide an outdoor learning space and shade cover for lunch.



OUTSIDE SCHOOL HOURS CARE GRANT

ADPS was successful in achieving a \$225,000 grant to be paid over three years to introduce Outside School Hours Care.
