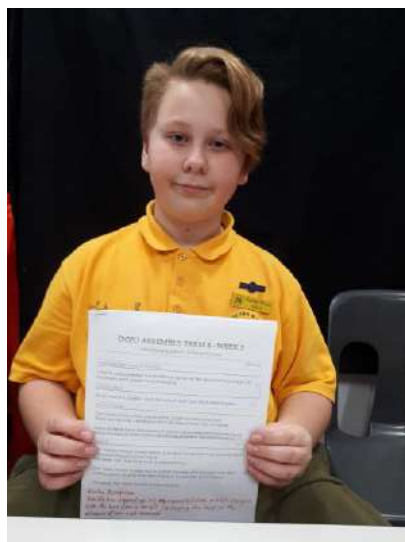
PRINCIPAL CHATTER

Congratulations to Chloe, Millar, Harley and Isla who read about their shared writing experience about what it would be like to be 100 years old.



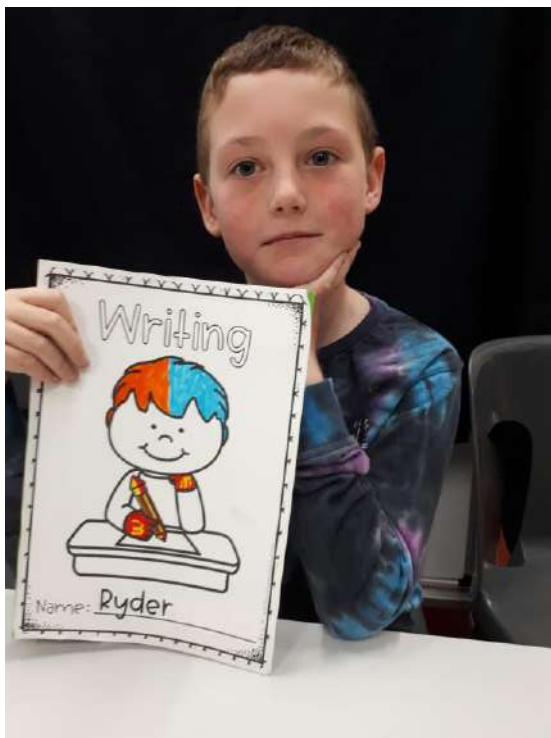
STUDENT SHOWCASE 2
