
### VALUES AWARD

Congratulations Stella for receiving last week's Values Award for the enthusiasm and effort you have put into your learning. Your story writing has gone to a new level. Great work Stella!




### STUDENT SHOWCASE (F)


### STUDENT SHOWCASE (F/1)

Congratulations Harley on reading your informative story about a boy named Bob and a dog named Bloop. Your story-writing has come a long way Harley. Keep up the great work!




### STUDENT SHOWCASE (1/2)
