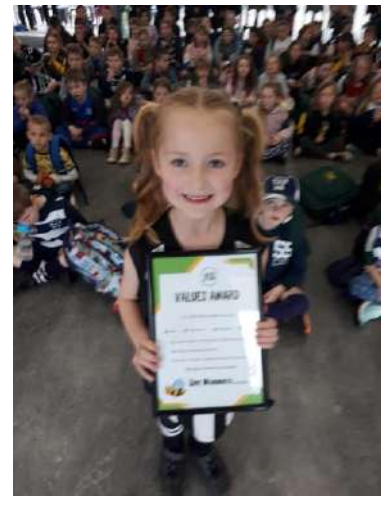
Whole School Assembly

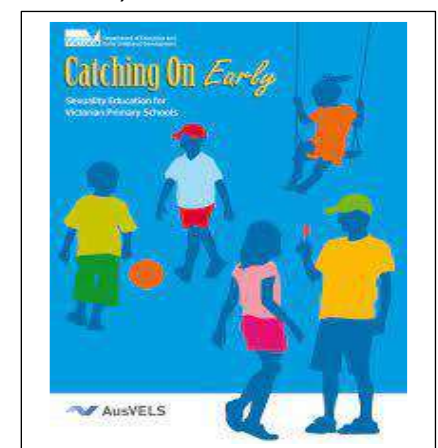

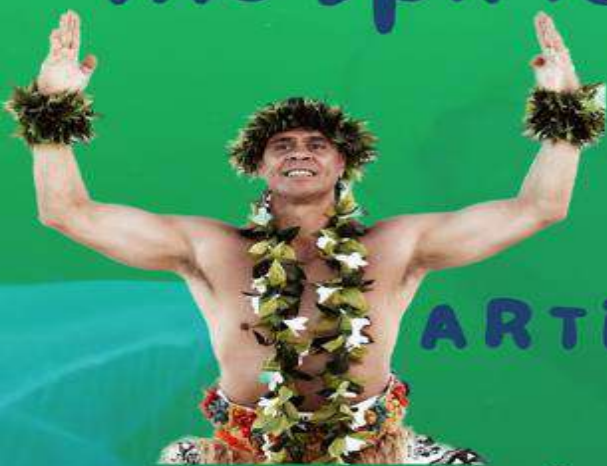
