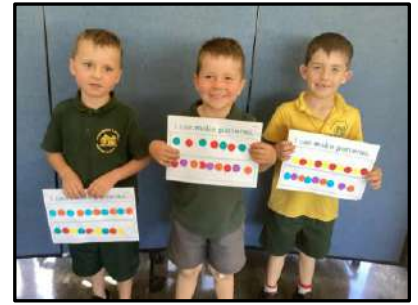
STUDENT LEADERS CONGRESS

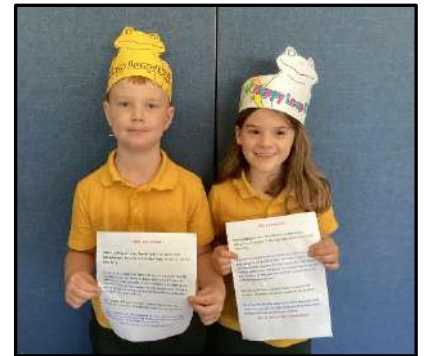
