Congratulations **Billy!**

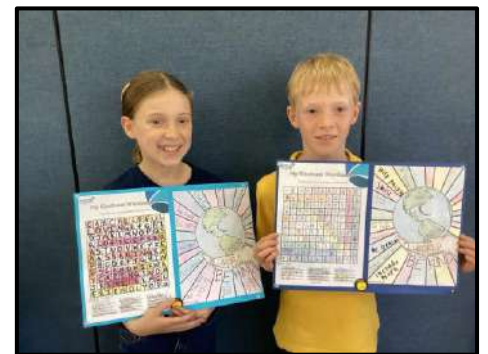


EDUCATION SUPPORT CELEBRATION

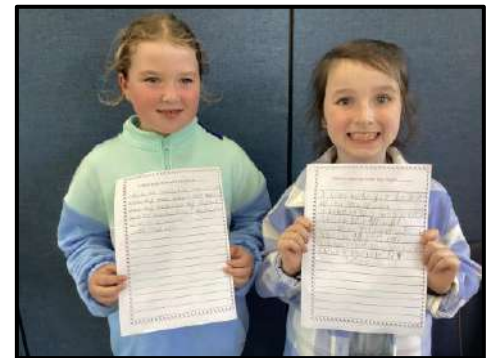
SHOWCASE 1

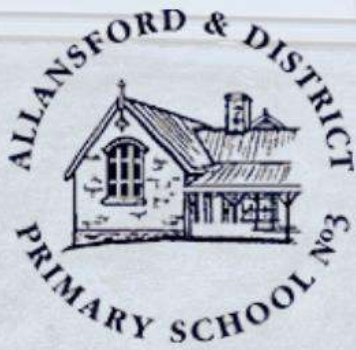
Toastie Tuesday

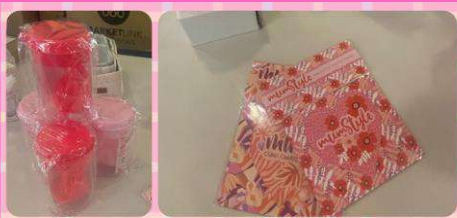
