Anyone that has uniform at home they would like to donate to the rack – please bring it in as we are getting low in stock and it's great to reuse.

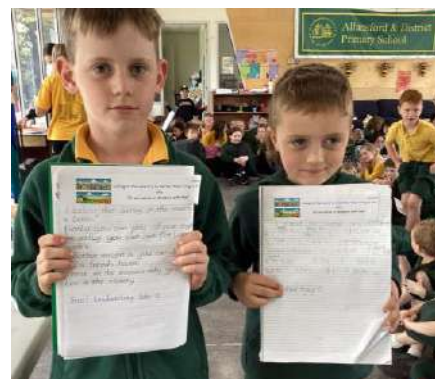
ENVIRONMENT SALT
