STUDENT ATTITUDE TO SCHOOL SURVEY

Our results this year were very pleasing, with ADPS performing above the state average in the majority of factors on the survey. School safety is always a key domain and regarding this we performed exceptionally well. 'In the domain of 'School Safety,' ADPS achieved above the state average in all three factors, those being 'Advocate at school,' 'Managing Bullying' and 'Respect for diversity. 'One factor we have been trying to grow is student voice and agency. We were pleased that we achieved 74% positive endorsement, some 8% higher than the state average.

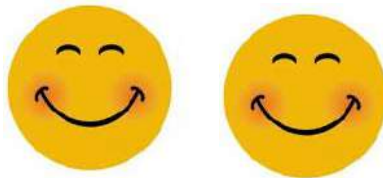
OUR MELO AWARD

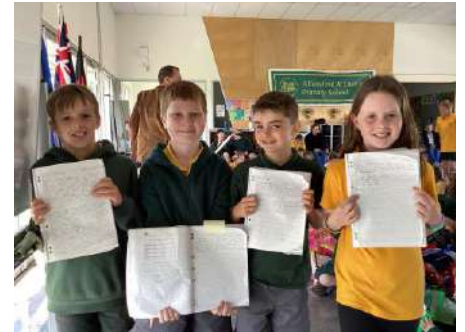
OUR VALUES AWARD

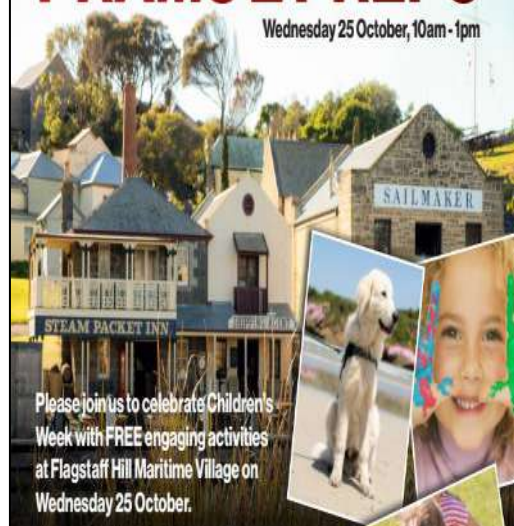
