#### **ACCIDENT INSURANCE COVER**

Please note, that with camps and swimming approaching, the department needs all parents to be aware of their stance in relation to student insurance and personal property. All water-based activities, excursions and camps require a Risk Register to be completed by the school, that identify possible risks, likelihood, consequences and actions to reduce risks.

#### STUDENT INSURANCE

Some school activities and physical education, particularly contact sports, carry inherent risks of injury. Parents are advised that the Department of Education does not have Student Accident Insurance cover for students.

Therefore, if your child is injured at school as a result of an accident or incident, all costs associated with the injury, including medical costs, are the responsibility of the child, parent or caregiver.

Some incidental medical costs may be covered by Medicare. If parents have private health insurance, some costs may also be covered through your private health insurance. Any other costs would be borne by the parents.

#### **PERSONAL GOODS**

Personal property is often brought to school by students, staff and visitors. This can include mobile phones, calculators, toys, sporting equipment and cars parked on school premises.

The Department of Education does not hold insurance for personal property brought to schools and it has no capacity to pay for any loss or damage to such property.

We acknowledge the traditional owners of the land, the Gunditjmara / Marr Nation people. We pay our respects to their elders past, present and emerging.




## Term 3
