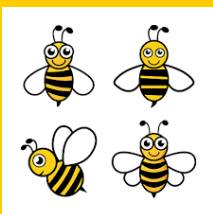

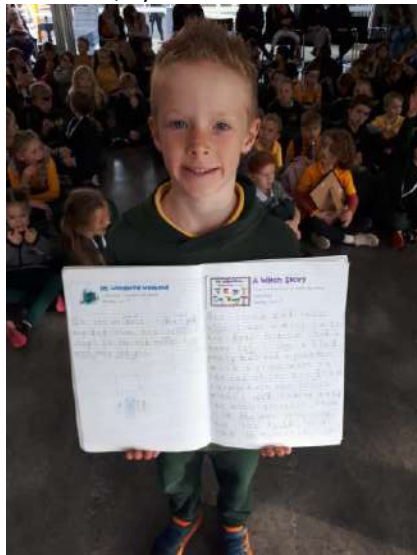


Students of the Week
